Petitioner has prayed for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.75 dated 03.09.2021 registered at Police Station Dera Baba Nanak, District Batala, Gurdaspur under Sections 307, 506, 148, 149, 427 of IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 (Section 307 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act deleted and Section 336 IPC and Section 27 of the Arms Act added later on).

Status report by way of affidavit of Shri Sarvanjit Singh PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Fatehgarh Churian, Additional charge of Sub Division Dera Baba Nanak, Police District Batala on behalf of respondent-State has been filed, as per which petitioner has since joined the investigation on 18.02.2023.

Vide order dated 13.02.2023, this Court while granting the concession of interim anticipatory bail directed the petitioner to join investigation.

Learned State counsel states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

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In view of the above, the petition is allowed. The order dated 13.02.2023 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to so so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
