This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing and setting aside the ex-parte order dated 11.07.2017 (Annexure P-8), order dated 24.07.2018 (Annexure P-9), sanad takseem dated 25.09.2018 (Annexure P-11) and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Since, an alternative remedy of filing a revision petition under Section 16 of the Punjab Land Revenue Act, before the Financial Commissioner is available to the petitioners, thus, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioners to file a revision petition under Section 16 of the said Act.

In view of the above-statement statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.
