SANJAY VASHISTH, J.

Prayer in the instant petition, filed by the petitioners, under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of directions to respondents Nos. 2 and 3, to provide protection of lives and liberty to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners herein and the other family members are doubted by private respondents that petitioner's son Satnam Singh (petitioner No. 3) is in love affairs with daughter of Hardev Singh @ Deba (respondent No. 4) and on that account, petitioner's family has been receiving threats time and again from the private respondents.

In this regard, already one representation dated 28.06.2022 (Anneuxre P-2) has been submitted to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar Rural by Davinder Kaur w/o Mangwinder Singh who is daughter in law of petitioners No. 1 and 2.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. J. S. Arora, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 (State).

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 –Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural), to look into representation dated 28.06.2022 (Annexure P-2) and after examining the same, if any substance of truth is found in regard to the apprehension of life and liberty of the petitioners, appropriate steps in accordance with law would be taken.
