This is a civil writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned order dated 15.07.2019 passed by the Financial Commissioner (Revenue) Punjab as well as order dated 16.10.2015 passed by the Commissioner, Ferozepur Division, Ferozepur and order dated 21.11.20213 passed by the District Collector-cum-Deputy Commissioner, Fazilka.

On 12.12.2019, a coordinate Bench of this Court was pleased to pass the following order in the connected petition bearing CWP-36051-2019:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for an adjournment to place on record the orders/judgments passed by the criminal Courts in the FIRs which are alleged to have been registered against respondent No.4.
