The petitioner through instant petition, under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is seeking direction to official respondents to protect life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members from the hands of respondent No.7, who in connivance with respondent Nos.4 and 5 is threatening the petitioner to entangle her in some false case.

The petitioner, for the redressal of her grievance, has filed representation dated 26.09.2022 (Annexure P-3) with S.S.P., Mohali, which has not been looked into by officer concerned.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Amish Sharma, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and assures that S.S.P., Mohali, would look into the representation dated 26.09.2022 (Annexure P-3) and redress the grievance of the petitioner.

This Court, in view of the statement of learned State counsel, is sanguine of the fact that competent authority would look into the matter and redress grievance(s) of the petitioner within two months from today.

No further order is warranted.
