The petitioner alleges violation of the order dated 16.09.1996, passed by the Civil Judge (Jr. Division), Ludhiana; judgment dated 11.09.1997 passed by the Additional District Judge, Ludhiana; order dated 05.11.2001 passed by this Court in RSA-3102-1997 as well as judgment dated 28.01.2011 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Civil Appeal No. 1132 of 2011.

Since the petitioner has a remedy of filing an eviction petition against the unauthorized occupants/private respondents under the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 and also in view of the fact that there is no specific direction by a competent Court after earmarking/demarcation of the area, which is stated to be under the possession of unauthorized persons/private respondents, no specific directions can be issued.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered

infructuous.

Rule stands discharged.

The petitioner is granted liberty to avail his alternative remedy in accordance with law, if so advised.
