Custody certificate furnished by the State is taken on record, as per which, custody period of the petitioner comes out to be 1 year and 11 months. As per status report received from the trial Court dated 2.5.2023, already 7 witnesses have been examined on behalf of the prosecution while 10 witnesses have been given up, meaning thereby, now only 4 prosecution witnesses remain to be examined.

2. At this stage, counsel for the petitioner made prayer that the present petition be disposed of with direction to the learned trial Court to expedite and conclude the trial in a time bound manner.

3. In view of above, present petition is hereby disposed of with direction to the learned trial court to conclude the trial expeditiously and to finally dispose of the case, preferably within next 5 months.
