427 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short, '*the IPC*') at Police Station NRI Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur including report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. submitted before the competent jurisdiction, along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

(2) Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Jatinder Pal Kaur has apprised the Court that in the aforesaid FIR, petitioner has already been convicted and released on probation on 02.12.2023 by learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Gurdaspur.

(3) In view of the abovesaid developments, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition may be disposed off as having been rendered infructuous.
