MAIN CASE

Applicant/appellant has filed the present appeal against the impugned judgment dated 25.11.2019, passed by learned Principal Magistrate, Juvenile Justice Board, Ludhiana, vide which, fine of Rs.500/- has been imposed upon respondent No.2 for the commission of offence punishable under Section 181 of the Motor Vehicle Act and he has been acquitted of the other charges.

- (2) Learned Counsel for the applicant/appellant submits that in view of the initial compromise dated 11.04.2023 and subsequent settlement dated 11.08.2023 (Annexures A-1 & A-2), respectively, entered into between the parties, present appeal be disposed off as not pressed.
- (3) Ordered accordingly.
- (4) CRM-39436-2023 for withdrawal of the main appeal on the basis of compromise is disposed off as having been rendered infructuous.
- (5) Needless to say that passing of this order be not construed as an expression of opinion regarding the genuineness of the aforesaid compromise, entered into between the parties.
- (6) Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
