1. This is a civil writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the order dated 16.05.2022 (Annexure P-4) passed by respondent no.1 and order dated 30.12.2020 (Annexure P-2) passed by respondent no.2.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner as well as respondents no.3 and 4 have jointly submitted that on 25.05.2023 a compromise has been effected between the petitioner and respondents no.3 and 4 before the Mediation Centre and a copy of said compromise has been placed on record. It is jointly prayed that the matter be disposed of in terms of said compromise and both the parties be bound by the terms and conditions of the compromise.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner as well as respondents no.3 and 4, the present petition is disposed of in terms of the compromise and the impugned orders dated 16.05.2022 and 30.12.2020 would stand modified in terms of the compromise. Both the parties would be bound by the said compromise.

It is made clear that in case any of the parties violate the terms and conditions of the said compromise, then apart from other legal remedies in law, it would be open to the other party to move an application for restoration of the present petition.
