This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to conduct demarcation in a free and fair manner and remove the encroachment from the land of the petitioners particularly encroachment done in khasra No.2398 situated at Sultanwind Sub-Urban, Taraf Behniwal, Tehsil and District Amritsar and other prayers have also been made.

2. On 05.05.2023, this Court had passed the following order:-
