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**N.S.Shekhawat J. (Oral)**

The petitioner has filed the present petition before this Court with a prayer to direct respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the lives, liberty and property of the petitioner and her family members.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondent No.4, who is the neighbour of the petitioner, has illegally encroached upon the street, adjoining the house of the petitioner and has been harassing and threatening her. Even the petitioner approached the Civil Court and filed a suit for mandatory injunction against the illegal encroachment made by respondent No.4, which is pending before the learned Court. Apart from that, the petitioner has also filed a criminal complaint against respondent No.4 under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C. The respondent No.4 alongwith some unknown persons had attacked the house of the petitioner and pressurised her to withdraw all the cases filed against respondent No.4 and while saving from the attack of respondent No.4 and other unknown persons, the petitioner received serious injuries and copy of the MLR was placed on record as Annexure P-3. Further, on 06.01.2023, respondents No.4 to 11 and some other unknown persons attacked the house of the petitioner

with sharp edged weapons, bricks and stones and forcibly tried to enter the house of the petitioner. However, the petitioner and her family members saved their lives with great difficulty and the entire incident was captured in the CCTV cameras installed outside the house of the petitioner. The petitioner made a complaint to the Police Station City, Kharar for appropriate action against the private respondents and for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members, but no action was taken. Consequently, a representation (Annexure P-5) was made to the Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali on 06.01.2023 and request was made to him to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner. However, no action has been taken on the said representation till date.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3, at this stage.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Vipin Pal Yadav, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Keeping in view the facts of the case and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed with a direction to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali to look into the representation (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate action as expeditiously as possible, in accordance with law.
