The petitioner is alleging violation of the order dated 24.04.2014 passed by this Court in CWP-7566-2014, vide which, the respondent-Trust was directed to decide the claim of the petitioner, by passing a speaking order.

Learned counsel for the respondent, on the basis of the affidavit filed by the Executive Officer, Improvement Trust, Ludhiana, submits that a speaking order has already been passed, however, when the same was sent to the Government, certain objections were raised regarding eligibility of the petitioner.

In view of the above, no further action is called for in the present petition and the same is disposed.

Rule stands discharged.

The petitioner is granted liberty to avail the alternative remedy, in accordance with law, if so advised.
