The petitioner has impugned the order dated 03.01.2013 whereby the application of the petitioner for ad interim injunction has been declined.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the respondent-defendant is raising construction in the agricultural land which would cause grave prejudice to the petitioner.

Heard.

The petitioner had filed a suit that he is co-owner in joint possession of agricultural land. The petitioner and the defendant are both co-sharers in the land. The land has not been partitioned. The petitioner had also not filed any site plan indicating the area under his possession. The petitioner himself is stated to have constructed a house in the suit land and, therefore, if the defendant is raising any construction that by itself would not give a ground to grant interim injunction in his favour.

Consequently, I do not find any merit in the instant petition which stands dismissed.
