This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 initiating appropriate legal action against private respondents No.4 and 5 and further prayer to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner who is 60% permanent disabled at the hands of private respondents, whereas respondent No.5 and brother of respondent No.4 has criminal antecedents.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Adhiraj Singh, AAG, Punjab puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3-State.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let this petition be disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Moga to consider and decide the representation dated 22.11.2022 (Annexure P-4) alleged to have been submitted by the petitioner.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioner and even the assertions set out in the petition, the present petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2 that if any such

representation, as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, it shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably within six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and convey the same to the petitioner.

The present petition stands disposed off accordingly.
