Reply by way of affidavit of Kanwaljeet Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police (Headquarters), Yamuna Nagar, dated 03.08.2023 has been placed on record by learned State counsel, as per which usually the presence of the petitioner is being marked in Courts by way of video conferencing and that on 26.10.2022, the petitioner was physically produced in Court at Kurukshetra and on 08.12.2022 in Court at Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage he would be satisfied in case a direction is given to produce the petitioner in different Courts through video conferencing and if for any reason, his physical presence is sought in any Court, then adequate security be provided.

The prayer made appears to be genuine. As such, it is directed that every effort be made to procure the presence of the petitioner in the trial

pending before different Courts by way of video conferencing and if, for any reason, any of the Courts asks for physical presence of the petitioner, then adequate security be arranged for his production before that Court.
