The challenge in the present petition, filed under Section 482 CrP.C., is to the order dated 06.07.2022 (Annexure P-7) whereby the charges under Sections 420 and 34 IPC were framed against the petitioner in Complaint No.COMI-1857-2013, and to order dated 18.10.2022 (Annexure P-8) passed by the learned Sessions Judge, Rewari, dismissing the revision petition preferred against the aforesaid order.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous as the petitioner has been convicted by the Trial Court and thus, prays that the same be disposed of as such.

3. Learned State counsel does not dispute the aforesaid submission.
