This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.1 and 2 for getting conducted free and fair investigation of the FIR No.147 dated 19.11.2022 under Sections 304-A/279 of IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Ahmedgarh, District Malerkotla, in which respondent No.3 is trying to falsely implicate the vehicle of the petitioner bearing truck No. PB04V-7399 and illegally harassing the petitioner and further to direct respondents No.2 & 3 to take legal action and decide representation dated 27.12.2022 (Annexure P-1).

Notice of motion.

Mr. Adhiraj Singh, AAG, Punjab puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3-State.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let this petition be disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Malerkotla, District Malerkotla (Punjab) to consider and decide the representation dated 27.12.2022 (Annexure P-1) alleged to have been submitted by the petitioner.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the claim

of the petitioner and even the assertions set out in the petition, the present petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2 that if any such representation, as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, it shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably within six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and convey the same to the petitioner.

The present petition stands disposed off accordingly.
