Instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing respondent No.3 to issue the Sports Gradation Certificate for Grade D as per the policy dated 25.05.2018, Annexure P-2.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that vide application dated 02.12.2022, which has been sent by speed post, Annexure P-5, petitioner had requested for issuance of a Sports Gradation Certificate, which is not being supplied to him. He submits that a direction be issued to the concerned respondent to look into his application and take appropriate action.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Pankaj Middha, Addl. A. G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Keeping in view the nature of order being passed, this Court does not deem it necessary to call upon the respondents to file a response.

Without commenting upon the controversy raised in the petition, writ petition is ordered to be disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to examine the application submitted by the petitioner and supply him the Sports Gradation Certificate, in case, he is entitled to the same, within a period of 04 weeks from the date of communication of this order. In case, the petitioner is not entitled to the certificate, a reasoned order be passed rejecting the application.

Till then, status quo qua the service of the petitioner as it exists today, be maintained.
