Prayer in this writ petition is for directing respondent-Bank to close/liquidate the loan account of the petitioners with a further prayer to quash sale notice (Annexure P-3) issued by respondent-Bank under Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act (SARFAESI Act), 2002.
