The instant petition has been filed by the petitioners seeking issuance of direction to official respondents so as to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners as they apprehend threat to the same at the hands of private respondents i.e. respondents No.6 to 11.

This Court finds that the petitioners had earlier also filed a similar petition wherein respondents No.6, 7, 8 and 9 were also impleaded as respondents and which was disposed of by this Court vide order dated 13.8.2021. The said order is reproduced hereunder:

“Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and without commenting anything as regards the veracity of the averments made in the petition, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Charkhi Dadri, to look into the matter and to dispose of the representation dated 23.7.2021 (Annexure P-1) in accordance with law. In case, it is found that there is genuine threat to the lives and liberty of the petitioners, then necessary steps warranted under law be taken thereupon at the earliest so as to ensure that no harm is caused to the petitioners.

A copy of this order along with copy of representation dated 23.7.2021 (Annexure P-1) be sent to respondent No.3-Superintendent of Police, Charkhi Dadri, for necessary compliance.”

Learned counsel submits that no action was taken by the police despite order dated 13.8.2021 and that now respondents No.10 and 11 are also issuing threats to cause harm to the petitioners. As far as the instant petition qua respondents No.6 to 9 is concerned, this Court already having issued directions does not deem it appropriate to entertain the petition qua the said respondents. However, as far as respondents No.10 and 11 are concerned, the instant petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.4-Superintendent of Police, Charkhi Dadri, Haryana, to look into the matter as regards the alleged threat perception of the petitioners qua respondents No.10 and 11.

It shall be open to the petitioners to file a detailed representation delineating the reasons for his apprehension qua respondents No.10 and 11. In case, any such representation is moved, respondent No.4-Superintendent of Police, Charkhi Dadri, Haryana shall get the same examined expeditiously. In case, it is found that there is genuine threat to the lives and liberty of the petitioners, then necessary steps warranted under law be taken thereupon at the earliest so as to ensure that no harm is caused to the petitioners.

A copy of this order be sent to respondent No.4-Superintendent of Police, Charkhi Dadri, for necessary compliance.
