The instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.0042, dated 22.02.2020, under Sections 306 and 34 of the IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Nissing, District Karnal.

Request for adjournment is declined particularly on the objection made by learned counsel for the petitioner, who neither informed nor any no objection was sought on the 'adjournment' slip filed by counsel for the complainant, Mr. Shekhar Verma, who has been seeking dates for last various occasions.

This Court vide order dated 19.07.2022, while issuing notice of motion, granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner, subject to his joining the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the order dated 19.07.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel does not controvert the said fact and further submits that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.

In view of the above, the order dated 19.07.2022 is made absolute.
