MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J.

Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for quashing of FIR No.122 dated 12.08.2022, under Sections 387 & 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station DLF Phase 2, District Gurugram along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 29.08.2022 (P-2), entered into between the parties i.e. petitioner as well as respondent No.2.

(2) This Court has gone through the contents of FIR.

Allegations are that on 12.08.2022, petitioner demanded a ransom of ₹ 4 Crores to be paid within four days and in case of failure, he

threatened to kidnap the minor child of complainant, aged 04 years, studying in Kinder Garten (K.G.)

(3) Since *prima facie*, the allegations are very serious; therefore, at this stage, no ground is made out to accept the prayer for quashing of the impugned FIR on the basis of compromise.

(4) Consequently, there is no option except to dismiss the petition.
Ordered accordingly.

(5) The observations, made above, be not considered as an expression of opinion on the merits of controversy in any manner.

(6) Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
