The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.69 dated 25.3.2019 registered under Sections 302, 323, 148, 149, 120-B IPC at Police Station, Samrala, District Ludhiana, wherein petitioner has been summoned to face trial in the application filed under Section 319 Cr.P.C by the learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Ludhiana.

By virtue of the order dated 16.1.2023 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to appear before the Trial Court within a period of one week and on doing so Trial Court was directed to admit the petitioner to interim bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to its satisfaction.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the order dated 16.1.2023 petitioner had appeared before the Trial Court within the given period and was also admitted to interim bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds by the Trial Court to its satisfaction.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Baldev Singh has endorsed the fact that petitioner has been admitted to interim bail by the

Trial Court.

In view of the above, the order dated 16.1.2023 is made absolute. Petitioner will keep on appearing before the Trial Court as and when required in accordance with law.
