DEEPAK MANCHANDA J. (ORAL)

Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for handing over the investigation of the case bearing FIR No. 225 dated 02.10.2022 registered under Sections 307 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25, 27 of Arms Act at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar (Rural), to some other independent agency or to some senior official.

On 28.02.2023, learned State counsel has filed short reply and a perusal of para Nos. 6 and 7 of the said reply reveals that allegations made by the petitioner were thoroughly investigated but the alleged involvement of respondent Nos. 5 to 8 in causing injuries to the petitioner with a firearm did not prove and it was found that injuries to petitioner were caused by one of the person out of three unidentified persons by firing shots from his firearm, who had snatched the mobile phone and motorcycle of the respondent No. 6 and the investigating officer is making sincere efforts to identify the real accused persons involved in the occurrence and to arrest them as early as possible.

In view of the above, nothing remains to be adjudicated in the present petition and the same is hereby disposed of, as such.
