CRM-M-1945-2023

This petition has been filed for grant of regular bail in FIR No.368, dated 30.06.2022, registered at Police Station Tehsil Camp, Panipat, under Sections 302 & 34 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has been in custody for more than six months. There is no other criminal case pending against him. The trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date as examination of Pws has not yet commenced. The petitioner is not alleged to have given the fatal blow to the deceased and thus, he may be granted regular bail.

Custody certificate dated 17.01.2023 digitally signed by Smt. Geeta Rani, Deputy Superintendent, District Prison, Panipat has been filed in Court. The same is taken on record. A perusal thereof shows that the petitioner has undergone actual custody of 06 months and 14 days and there is no other criminal case pending against him.

Learned State counsel concedes that examination of Pws has not yet started. He also concedes that the petitioner is not alleged to have inflicted the fatal blow.

Keeping in view the role of the petitioner as well as the fact that the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date, I deem it appropriate to grant him regular bail. Accordingly, the petition is allowed. He is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
