Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jaswant Singh, states that pursuant to the order passed by this Court, dated 13.01.2023, the petitioner has joined the investigation and recovery has also been effected from him, but certain gold articles still remain to be recovered.

2. It is settled that custodial interrogation of an accused cannot be granted for effecting recovery of alleged gold articles, as entrustment of the articles itself is a matter of trial.

3. In view thereof, the present petition is allowed. Interim order dated 13.01.2023, passed by this Court, is made absolute.
