Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.701 dated 02.12.2022 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Tosham, District Bhiwani.

Vide order dated 12.01.2023 passed by a Coordinate Bench, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 12.01.2023, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Dharamvir, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation.
