Prayer in the present revision petition filed under Section 102 of Juvenile Justice (Care & Protection of Children) Act, 2015 is for declaring the petitioner as juvenile in case bearing FIR No.124 dated 28.12.2017 under Sections 302 and 201 of IPC, registered at Police Station Kotwali, Nabha.

Short reply by way of affidavit of Davinder Kumar, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Circle Nabha, District Patiala on behalf of respondent No.1-State of Punjab, has been filed, which is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to the counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel submits that vide judgment dated 16.07.2022 passed by the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Patiala (Annexure R-1 of aforesaid reply), the petitioner has been acquitted by the trial Court. Therefore, the instant petition is rendered infructuous.
