1. Petitioner (Rajeev) has filed the present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of case FIR No.374 dated 13.07.2019 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 323, 452 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Meham, District Rohtak along with all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of affidavit of respondent No.2, namely Sushma, dated 26.11.2019 (Annexure P-2), admitting the factum of compromise arrived at between her and the petitioner.

2. A perusal of file reveals that no one is appearing to represent the parties since last two dates, i.e. 02.11.2022 and 13.04.2023. Vide order dated 13.04.2023, registry was directed to notify learned counsel for the petitioner as well as respondent No.2 of the next date of hearing, i.e.

03.05.2023 (today).

As per office report, learned counsel for the petitioner was informed of the date fixed (03.05.2023) and information letter sent to respondent No.2 in terms of order dated 13.04.2023 has also been received back served through her mother. However, even today, no one has appeared to represent the petitioner or respondent No.2.

4. It appears that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant matter any further.

5. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
