The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari seeking quashing the action of respondents No.7 and 8 in recovering the vehicle of the petitioner bearing No.PB-04AB-3727 with the help of recovery agents on 12.11.2021.

Written statement on behalf of the respondents No.7 and 8 has been filed today. Copy thereof has been furnished to learned counsel for the petitioner.

It has been specifically averred in the abovesaid reply that the petitioner has concealed the material facts/particulars. It is averred that the loan cancellation notice had also been specifically served upon the petitioner. The proceedings were then referred to Arbitration, wherein an auction Award was passed. Subsequent, thereto, pre-intimation and post-intimation notice had also been sent. The vehicle in question was repossessed on 12.12.2021. The present petition was filed in 2022 while concealing the aforesaid facts.

Counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to take recourse to the alternative efficacious remedies available to him in accordance with law.

Disposed of as withdrawn with the liberty as aforesaid.
