Present writ petition has been filed for quashing the impugned inquiry reports dated 26.10.2018 (Annexure P-1) and dated 14.11.2018 to 26.11.2018 (Annexure P-2) of respondent No.5/BDPO being discriminative, unfair, wrong, illegal and also against the principles of natural justice. Further prayer has been made for directing the official respondents to take legal action to remove respondent No.7 from the post of Panch of Ward No.8 being disqualified for the same in view of provisions of Sections 175(1)(i & n) and 177(1)b of the Haryana Panchayati Raj Act, 1994, who has failed to pay arrears due by him to the Gram panchayat land bearing khasra No.265 and for directing respondents No.2 to 6 to recover the possession of the land in question in view of order

dated 31.05.2017 passed by this Court in CWP No.4886 of 2017 vide which this Court had directed the official respondents to take appropriate action in terms of order dated 10.05.2013 (Annexure P-3).

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that tenure of the petitioner has already been over, therefore, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same may be disposed of as such.

In view of this, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
