The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.236 dated 26.11.2022 registered under Section 306 IPC at Police Station, City Kotkapura, District Faridkot.

By virtue of the order dated 16.1.2023 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the order dated 16.1.2023 petitioner has joined investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.
