1. Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that CRR(F)-87-2023, titled as *Ankit Aggarwal Vs. Arjita Gupta*, has been rendered infructuous as the main petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C filed by the respondent-wife, before the learned Family Court, Rewari, has been withdrawn in terms of the compromise dated 29.05.2023, and seeks that the present petition be disposed as such.

Prayer in the present petition is for modification of the order dated 13.12.2022 passed by the learned Addl. District Judge-cum-Family Court, Rewari, vide which the petitioner has been granted maintenance only Rs.20,000/- per month, with the said maintenance sought to be enhanced.

Learned counsel for the parties submit that this petition too rendered infructuous in view of the fact that the petitioner-wife herein has withdrawn the petition filed by her under Section 125 Cr.P.C before the learned Family Court, Rewari. As such, they seek withdrawal of the present petition.
