The present petition has been filed for seeking issuance of directions to the respondents No.1 to 3 to initial legal/departamental proceedings against respondent No.4.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was tortured at Police Station Dharamkot and a complaint in this regard was submitted to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga and that the aforesaid complaint was not being inquired into.

A short reply by way of affidavit of Ravinder Singh, DSP, Dharamkot, District Moga had been filed in Court, wherein it was submitted pursuant to the receipt of the complaint/application, a DDR No.23 dated 10.10.2019 was duly recorded in the Police Station. An inquiry was also conducted by the then S.H.O. wherein the allegations levelled by the petitioner were found false. Another DDR No.55 dated 31.10.2019 in this regard was also recorded in the Register of the Police Station.

Despite the aforesaid having been filed in November 2022, no replication/rejoinder controverting the aforesaid aspect has been filed by the petitioner.

In view of the aforesaid affidavit, learned counsel for the petitioner does not wish to press the instant petition and prays for granting the liberty the petitioner to take recourse to other alternative efficacious remedies available to him in accordance with law.

Disposed of as not pressed with the liberty as aforesaid.

Any other misc. application(s) also stand(s) disposed of accordingly.
