The prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.242, dated 01.11.2019, under Sections 323, 307, 336, 148, 149 of IPC, 1860 and Sections 25 & 27 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Beas, District Amritsar Rural, Amritsar along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

Mr. Gobind Singh Randhawa, Advocate has appeared and filed his power of attorney on behalf of respondent No.2, with no objection from the earlier counsel, today in the Court and the same is taken on record.

Status report dated 07.02.2023 by way of an affidavit of Harkrishan Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Baba Bakala Sahib, Amritsar Rural on behalf of respondent No.1-State has been filed today in the Court and the same is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to the counsel opposite.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.2 submits that there is no compromise effected between the parties for the offence punishable under Section 307 of IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, which are non-compoundable.
