Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing the impugned order dated 03.01.2019 (Annexure P-4) passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar, dismissing the application dated 04.12.2018 (Annexure P-3) filed by the petitioner for releasing his passport, on account of his acquittal in case FIR No. 18 dated 15.05.2011 registered under Sections 498-A and 406 IPC at Police Station D-Division, Amritsar, vide judgment dated 28.11.2018 (Annexure P-2).
