By this common order, CRM-M-2563-2023 & CRM-M-2665-2023 are being disposed of as both the petitions are interconnected. For the sake of convenience facts are borrowed from CRM-M-2563-2023.

Through the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioners are seeking direction to higher police officials to lodge FIR against respondent No.2 who has filed a complaint/application under Section 156 (3) Cr.P.C., seeking registration of FIR against the petitioners.

The petitioner No.1, *inter alia* submits that respondent No.2 who is wife of petitioner No.1 has filed petition under Section 156(3)

&

Cr.P.C. seeking registration of FIR against the petitioners. The petitioner No.3 is suffering from Cancer and she is a 60 years old lady still she has been implicated. The petitioner No.2 is a 71 years old man. The petitioner Nos.4 and 5 are staying separate from petitioner No.1 still they have been implicated.

I have heard arguments of petitioner No.1 and scrutinized the record.

From the perusal of zimini orders of the Trial Court, it comes out that till date no final order has been passed by jurisdictional Magistrate and the matter is still pending for further consideration. The petitioners have filed complaints with police authorities who are expected to look into the matter as per law of the land.

In view of the fact that jurisdictional Magistrate is seized of the matter and till date no order of registration of FIR has been passed, the present petitions are premature and deserve to be dismissed and accordingly dismissed.
