Present application has been filed for recalling the order dated 05.05.2023 passed by this Court by which, the main appeal was dismissed for non-prosecution.

Keeping in view the averments made in the application, which are duly supported by an affidavit, application is allowed. Order dated 05.05.2023 passed by this Court is recalled and the main appeal is ordered to be restored to its original number and status and is taken up for hearing today itself.

1. Present regular second appeal has been filed challenging the

judgment and decree of the lower Appellate Court dated 19.11.2019 by which, the judgment and decree of the trial Court dated 03.09.2019 has been set aside and the suit filed by the respondent-plaintiff was allowed.

2. As per office report, the respondent has already been served as far back in July, 2022 but no one is appearing on his behalf, hence respondent is proceeded ex-parte.

3. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that the findings have been recorded by the Courts below that the process envisaged under Section 126 of the Electricity Act, 2003 for provisional assessment of liability has not been followed and the recovery of the amount has been fastened upon the consumer by violating the rules of natural justice.

4. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, the present appeal may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the appellant to pass a fresh order of assessment in accordance with law after following due process of law as envisaged under the Electricity Act, 2003 by giving due opportunity of defence to the consumer.
