The present appeal has been filed by the appellant against the order dated 05.01.2023 whereby the application moved by the appellant for grant of bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in criminal case having FIR No. 804 dated 12.12.2022 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 147, 149, 323, 341, 506 of IPC and under Sections 3 (1) (r), 3(2) (s), 3(2) (Va) of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Attrocities) Act, 1989 at Police Station Surajkund, Faridabad, is dismissed.

Vide detailed order dated 13.01.2023 passed by this court wherein the appellant was granted interim protection with direction to join the investigation.

Today, the counsel for the appellant has apprised the Court that the appellant has joined the investigation with the police in compliance of the previous order of interim bail.

The State counsel on instructions from PSI Vivek Malik submits that indeed the appellant has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation or custodial interrogation and police has prepared the challan which will be filed very shortly in the Court concerned against the petitioner and other accused persons.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail order dated 13.01.2023 is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner should abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
