The petitioner has approached this Court through the instant Revision Petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the order dated 12.02.2018 passed by the court of learned Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Rewari, whereby the application filed by the petitioner/defendant no.3 seeking permission to lay tiles and stone on the floor of the house in question has been dismissed by the trial court.
