The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.145 dated 04.05.2019 under Section 22 (C) of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Rania, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and has been arraigned as an accused on the disclosure statement of co-accused Kuldeep alias Deepu who has been granted regular bail by this Court in CRM-M-13383-2022 on 18.05.2022.

This Court had dismissed the first bail application preferred by the petitioner on 05.01.2021 after noticing that he was in regular touch with co-accused Kuldeep alias Deepu on telephone prior to the alleged recovery from the house of co-accused. The call details have been set out in the affidavit filed by Deputy Superintendent of Police, Ellenabad, District Sirsa in the first bail petition. The petitioner is stated to be running a medical pharmacy and is alleged to have supplied intoxicant tablets to co-accused Kuldeep alias Deepu. 58,600 tablets of Tramadol with a total weight of 31.386 kgs. were alleged to have been recovered from the house of co-accused.

Consequently, I do not find any good ground to take another view
in the matter and the petition stands dismissed.
