Mr. Aman Pal, on instructions from Er. Raminderjit Singh, Deputy Chief Engineer, Controller of Stores and Disposal (South), PSPCL, Patiala submits that though the fact w.r.t. filing of the affidavit by respondent No.4 himself cannot be defended, but the fact remains that vide office dated 16.01.2023 (P-5), a Higher Committee comprising of Controller of Stores and Disposal (South), Patiala and Controller of Stores and Disposal (North), Ludhiana under the supervision of Chief Engineer/S&W, PSPCL, Ludhiana was constituted to supervise work and conduct of the individual officers and stock verification committees. The Committee has already submitted its report which stands approved as well by the CMD indicting 09 persons. He submits that the findings of the Inquiry Committee would be taken to their logical end subject to provisions of law.

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2. Mr. Bhardwaj, counsel for the petitioner submits that the
fear of the petitioner stands allayed at this stage.
3. In view of the above, nothing survives in the present writ
petition at the hands of this Court and the same is disposed off having
been rendered infructuous. However, respondent No.4 is warned for
future.
4. Ordered accordingly.
