1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India challenging the order passed by the Divisional Commissioner, Ambala dated 26.11.2022 (Annexure P-1) wherein the temporary release of the petitioner of 6 weeks on regular parole on the basis of personal bonds was rejected.
2. The warrant had been issued for release on 07.12.2022 on an earlier occasion whereby he was required to furnish two sureties to the satisfaction of the District Magistrate, Sonapat in the sum of Rs.1 lakh each for observance of the conditions specified in the release warrant.
3. A perusal of the reply would go on to show that the petitioner was thereafter released on parole after furnishing of necessary surety bonds before the CJM, Sonapat and the petitioner was on parole till 05.03.2023. In such circumstances, this Court is of the considered opinion that the present petition has been rendered infructuous as the petitioner has already been released on parole after furnishing the requisite sureties.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
