Petitioner is seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents to initiate legal action and register a FIR against private respondents No.5 to 8, who have allegedly forged the Will of mother of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite a complaint (Annexure P-4) having been given way back on 19.09.2022, the official respondents have been sitting over the matter and have not registered a FIR against the accused persons, who are roaming around freely.

Notice of motion.

Mr. P.S.Paul, Addl. P.P.UT Chandigarh accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jarnail Singh has apprised the Court that subsequent to the receipt of the complaint, an inquiry was carried out by respondent No.4 and no substance was found in the allegations levelled by the petitioner and it was concluded that in fact it

was a case of civil nature between the parties. Learned State counsel further submits that as a result thereof, the complaint filed by the petitioner stands filed.

In the wake of submissions made by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would not press the present petition and would avail the alternative remedies as may be available in accordance with law.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
