The petitioner herein seeks the indulgence of this Court for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing official respondents No.2 & 3 to protect her life and liberty and not to entertain any criminal complaint against her and she further prays to refrain respondents No.4 & 5 from harassing her and also from interfering in her peaceful life.

2. Status-report has already been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 by way of the affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

3. Learned State counsel refers to Para No.6 in the Status-report wherein it has specifically been mentioned that the petitioner has been provided the mobile phone numbers of the SHO, Police Station Zirakpur,

the Incharge, Police Post Baltana and the Control Room as well, with the instructions to her to call immediately on any of these numbers in case, she apprehends threat to her life and liberty and he further points out that in Para No.7 in the same, it has also categorically been deposed that the proceedings under Sections 107/151 Cr.P.C have already been carried out against respondent No.4.

4. In view of the afore-discussed contents of the Status-report, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not want to press for the adjudication of the present petition on merits, at this stage and the same may be disposed of.

5. Learned State counsel has no objection for the same.

6. Resultantly, the petition in hand stands disposed of as having not been pressed for its adjudication on merits, at this stage.
