AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

1. This petition was filed seeking directions to the respondents to expedite the repatriation process of the petitioner.
2. The petitioner is a Pakistani citizen and was convicted in FIR No. 146, dated 5th September, 2021, under Section 3/34/20 of Indian Passport Act, 1921 and 14 of Foreigners Act, 1946, registered at Police Station Sadar Ferozepur, Punjab.
3. As per the pleadings in the petition, he had undergone the sentence awarded in the trial.
4. Learned Senior Panel counsel for UOI on instructions submits that repatriation process has been completed and petitioner has been repatriated on 14th July, 2023.
5. Learned counsel for the petitioner is not disputing the statement made by learned Senior panel counsel for respondent-UOI.
6. In view of the above, no further directions are called for, the petition is disposed of.
7. Since the main case has been disposed of, pending application if any is rendered infructuous.
