The present writ petition has been filed for issuance of directions to the respondents to grant benefit of enhanced remuneration to the petitioners w.e.f. 19.10.2021, in pursuance of the notification dated 27.10.2021 issued by respondent No.3.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that earlier, the petitioners approached this Court by way of CWP-11901-2020, to grant benefit of enhanced remuneration w.e.f. 01.04.2019; that vide order dated 09.02.2021 passed by a Coordinate Bench, the aforesaid writ petition was disposed of as having become infructuous for the reason that necessary relief had been granted to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further contends that vide notification(s) dated 19.10.2021/27.10.2021 issued by respondent No.3, remuneration has been enhanced to Rs.44,900/- w.e.f. 19.10.2021, but till date, the benefit of enhanced remuneration has not been granted to the petitioners.

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Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the petitioners have already raised the said grievance before the respondents by sending the legal notices dated 13.12.2022 (Annexures P-5 to P-9), which are still pending consideration and the petitioners would be satisfied in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.3 to decide the said legal notices.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. R.S.Budhwar, Addl. A.G. Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents-State and raises no objection in deciding the legal notices dated 13.12.2022 (Annexures P-5 to P-9) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made by the learned counsel for the petitioners during the course of hearing, but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, respondent No.3 is directed to decide the legal notices dated 13.12.2022 (Annexures P-5 to P-9) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
