The petitioner through instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is seeking direction to official respondents to investigate the case arising out of FIR No.0158 dated 19.11.2022 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 363 and 366 of IPC registered at Police Station Goraya, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, *inter alia* submits that police has registered afore-stated FIR, however, it is not making free and fair investigation.

Mr. Amish Sharma, AAG, Punjab, who is present in Court on advance notice, accepts notice on behalf of official respondents and assures the Court that police authorities would look into the matter and redress the grievance of the petitioner.
