1. Present civil writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing/setting aside the charge-sheet dated 30.11.2021 (Annexure P-7), with a further prayer for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to defer the departmental proceedings against the petitioner till the final outcome of the criminal case.

2. Learned State counsel has pointed out that in the present case, the departmental proceedings have culminated and a show cause notice dated 17.02.2022 had been issued, in which, it had been stated to give an opportunity to the petitioner to show as to why the major punishment be not imposed upon her and the petitioner has filed a reply dated 03.03.2022 to the said show cause notice and thus, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has raised several pleas in the present writ petition including the plea that she has been implicated in the present case on the asking of her husband and thus, the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to take up all the pleas, which have been raised in the present writ petition and are available to her in the departmental proceedings.

4. In view of the above, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty to the petitioner to take up all the pleas, which have been raised in the present writ petition and are available to her, in accordance with law, in the departmental proceedings.
